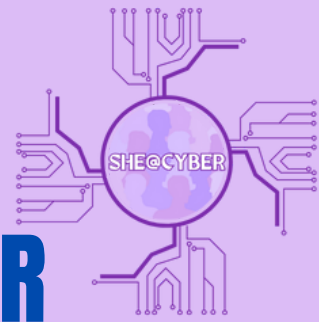
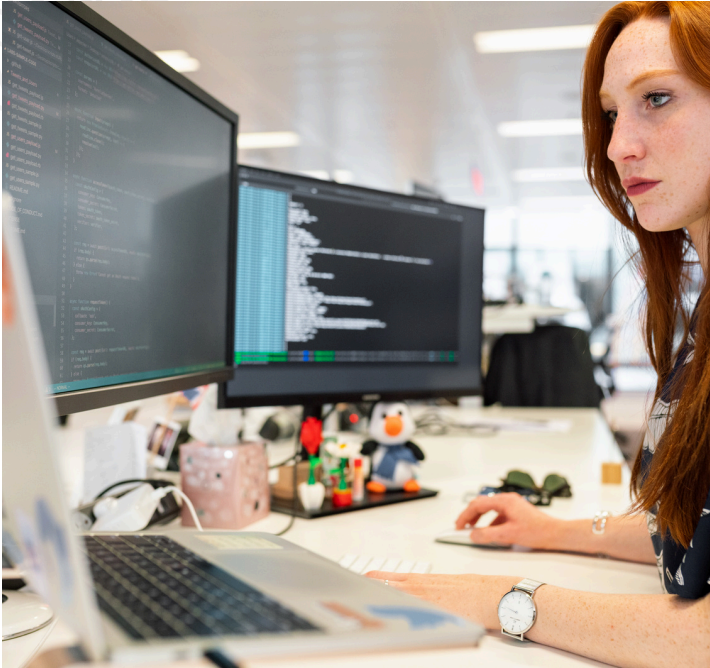

#### **Empowering Women in Cybersecurity: The She@Cyber Initiative**

The She@Cyber project is transforming Europe's cybersecurity landscape by tackling the gender gap in technology. Developed under the Erasmus+ programme and supported by key partners such as Vernian RTI, Innovation Hive, Geinnova, ISACA Europe, and Exeo Labs, the initiative provides practical, inclusive learning opportunities designed for women and learners from non-technical backgrounds.

- Development of open-access professional training programmes
- Creation of a roadmap for vocational cybersecurity education
- Implementation across five European countries
- Specific focus on empowering women from non-technical fields

ISACA Europe, a core partner in She@Cyber, has officially renewed its pledge to the EU Cybersecurity Skills Academy, which is now featured on the European Commission website.

ISACA Europe is the first and only organisation currently to renew its pledge. This reinforces its dedication to workforce upskilling, gender equality, academic collaboration, and scholarship opportunities. These efforts contribute to Europe's cybersecurity talent pipeline and will continue through December 2026, with progress updates shared with the European Commission every six months.
